Chemotherapy Induced Acute and Chronic Pain Syndromes

- Discuss the pathophysiology of chemotherapy-induced neuropathy.
- Differentiate between sensory and motor dysfunction associated with chemotherapy-induced neuropathy.
- Describe assessment and pain management interventions for the management of chemotherapy-induced neuropathy.
